

CM/ECF Modifications Effective 12/1/2017 due to Rule Changes

MODIFIED POC DEADLINES:

New Proof of Claim (POC) deadlines (does not affect Government POC ddls)

New Cases:

Vol Ch 7A	POC = Case Filed Date + 70 days
Invol Ch 7A	POC = Order For Relief Date + 90 days
Ch 12	POC = Case Filed Date + 70 days
Ch 13	POC = Case Filed Date + 70 days
Ch 11	POC = 341Date + 90 days (this one did not change)

Conversion:

to Ch 12	POC = Case Convert Date + 70 days
to Ch 13	POC = Case Convert Date + 70 days
to Ch 11	POC = 341Date + 90 days (this one did not change)

to Ch 7 (this one did not change)
If the Ch 7 trustee determines there are assets in a case that converts to a Ch 7, a 90 day deadline will be set and it will run from the date the *Notice to Creditors to File Claims* entry is made.

MODIFIED EVENTS:

Objection to Claim

Chapter 13 Plan and Amended Chapter 13 Plan

The Chapter 13 plan has embedded reliefs available, and THREE of these reliefs need to be reported to the Administrative Office of the U.S. Courts for statistical purposes. Therefore, the following is a new selection screen within the Chapter 13 Plan and the Amended Chapter 13 Plan events:

Select all of the following requests that are included within the Chapter 13 Plan (Click Next if none of these requests are included in the plan.):

- Request for valuation of security, payment of fully secured claims, and modification of undersecured claims [Provisions 7 & 8]
- Request for lien avoidance [Provision 12]
- Request to surrender collateral [Provision 9]
- Request for assumption of executory contracts and/or unexpired leases [Provision 16]

Motions/Applications (BK) menu:

Motion to Declare Secured Claim Satisfied and Lien Released

Rule 5009 allows the debtor (Chapter 12 or Chapter 13 case) to request by motion, an order declaring that secured claim(s) have been satisfied and the lien has been released under terms of the confirmed plan.

Claim Actions menu:

Proof of Claim Attachment (Rule 3001(c)(1)(d))

This event was added to allow attachments to proof of claims per F.R.B.P. 3002(c)(7). The event references a claim number and appears as a related supporting document on the Claims Register.
