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ORDER MODIFYING CASE MANAGEMENT ORDER

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On September 3, 1999, a Case Management Order was entered. The Case Management Order provided for joint administration of the above-captioned Chapter 11 estates. The clerk was instructed to docket all future entries in the cases under case number 99-28923-L only with the exception of certain items which were to be maintained in each individual case file. Included in the list of items were proofs of claim; and

IT APPEARING TO THE COURT that there may be claimants who assert claims against more than one of the bankruptcy estates; that requiring such claimants to include the same information and/or documentation with each such claim may be unnecessary and burdensome; and, that the Case Management Order should be modified to provide for an alternative method for filing multiple claims in these cases;

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IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED THAT as an alternative to filing a proof of claim containing the same information and/or documentation in each case, a claimant asserting a claim against more than one estate may utilize the following alternative approach:

1. Claimant may file a Master Proof of Claim in the case of Meridian Corporation a/k/a Medshares, Inc., case number 99-28923-L.
2. The Master Proof of Claim shall identify each estate against which the claim is being asserted by case name and case number, shall identify the basis for each such claim, shall state the total amount of the claim in each case at the time the case was filed and otherwise provide the information and documentation required by Official Form 10. Multiple affiliated claimants may join in filing a Master Proof of Claim as long as each claimant, the basis for its claim and the claim amount are identified.
3. If the claimant elects to file a Master Proof of Claim, claimant nevertheless must file a proof of claim in each individual case against which the claimant has asserted a claim as set forth in the Master Proof of Claim, which proof of claim shall direct the person reviewing such claim to the claimant's Master Proof of Claim form filed in the case of Meridian Corporation a/k/a Medshares, Inc., case number 99-28923-L.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED THAT nothing herein shall be deemed to affect the substantive rights and remedies of the claimants or the Debtors and this Order shall be construed as only affecting the procedures by which proofs of claim may be filed in these cases.
