

Electronic Filing of Claims

Beginning January 12, 2004, all claims should be directed to the [Clerk's Office](#) in the appropriate divisional office. Until further notice, claims will continue to be accepted *in paper format*.

For creditors wishing to eliminate postage costs and speed processing time by filing claims electronically, a limited use password was available for use beginning January 12, 2004, for filing Proofs of Claim in Chapter 7, 9, 11 and 12 cases. Beginning October 4, 2004, the Court is accepting claims electronically for Chapter 13 cases as well. Any creditors interested in filing claims electronically for these chapters must complete a limited use password registration form and submit it to the address on the form. Once the form is processed, a court representative will contact you with further details. If additional information is needed, please contact:
