**AGREED ORDER GRANTING RELIEF FROM THE

The debtor, by approval of this order, agrees to the abandonment and termination of the automatic stay as to the property described herein.

1. The abandonment is approved.

2. The secured creditor listed above is hereby granted relief from the automatic stay provisions of 11 U.S.C. § 362 to permit the secured creditor to proceed with the enforcement of the security interest in the above-described property, pursuant to applicable state law or federal law.
