The following is a list of the filing fees charged by the United States Bankruptcy Court pursuant to the requirements of **28 U.S.C. § 1930 (a)-(b)** and **Bankruptcy Court Miscellaneous Fee Schedule**:

**\*NEW CASE FILING FEES:**

Chapter 7 Case Filing Fee = **Total: \$338.00**  
Chapter 9 Case Filing Fee = **Total: \$1738.00**  
Chapter 11 Case Filing Fee = **Total: \$1738.00**  
Chapter 12 Case Filing Fee = **Total: \$278.00**  
Chapter 13 Case Filing Fee = **Total: \$313.00**  
Chapter 15 Case Filing Fee = **Total: \$1738.00**

**CASE REOPENING FEES:**

Chapter 7 Case Reopening Fee = **Total: \$260.00**  
Chapter 9 Case Reopening Fee = **Total: \$ 1167.00**  
Chapter 11 Case Reopening Fee = **Total: \$1167.00**  
Chapter 12 Case Reopening Fee = **Total: \$200.00**  
Chapter 13 Case Reopening Fee = **Total: \$235.00**  
Chapter 15 Case Reopening Fee = **Total: \$1167.00**

**ADVERSARY PROCEEDING FILING FEE** (AS DEFINED BY FRBP 7001) = **Total \$350.00**

**Please Note:** If the debtor or the United States, other than a U.S. Trustee acting as a case trustee, is the plaintiff, or if a child support creditor or its representative is the plaintiff and an "Appearance of Child Support Creditor or Authorized Representative" has been filed, no fee is required. If a trustee or DIP is the plaintiff, the fee should be payable only from the estate and to the extent there is any estate realized.)

**CASE CONVERSION FEES**

Motion or Notice to Convert Ch. 13 Case to Ch. 7 = **Total \$25.00**  
Motion to Convert Ch. 9 or Ch. 11 Case to Ch. 7 = **Total \$ 15.00**  
Motion to Convert Ch. 12 Case to Ch. 7 = **Total \$ 60.00**  
Motion to Convert Ch. 7 to Ch. 11 = **Total \$ 922.00**  
Motion to Convert Ch. 13 to Ch. 11 = **Total \$932.00**

**Please Note:** If the case trustee is the movant, the fee shall be payable only from the estate that exists prior to conversion)

**\*MISCELLANEOUS PROCEEDING FILING FEE:**

Filing any document not related to a pending case or proceeding = **Total \$49.00**

**Please Note: Examples:** Certification of Judgment For Registration in Another District, Issuance of Out of District Summons/Subpoena or Matters Deemed as Misc. Proceedings by presiding judge on case by case basis

- \*Motion To Divide (Sever/Split) Joint Case under 11 U.S.C. § 302**
- Chapter 7 = **Total \$ 338.00**
- Chapter 11 = **Total \$ 1738.00**
- Chapter 12 = **Total \$ 278.00**
- Chapter 13 = **Total \$ 313.00**
- \*Motion For Relief From Stay (11 U.S.C. § 362(a)) = Total \$188.00**
- \*Motion To Compel Abandonment (FRBP 6007(b)) = Total \$188.00**
- \*Motion To Withdraw Reference of Case Proceeding (28 U.S.C. § 157(d)) = Total \$188.00**
- \*Motion To Sell Property of Estate Free and Clear of Liens under 11 U.S.C. § 363(f) = Total \$188.00**
- \*Motion For Protective Order or Restrict Public Access (to redact bankruptcy records) = Total \$26.00 (per motion in each affected case)**

**Please Note:** Motions for relief from the co-debtor stay, and for stipulations for court approval of an agreement regarding relief from stay are exempt from this fee. Also, if a child support creditor or it's representative is the movant and an "Appearance of Child Support Creditor or Authorized Representative" has been filed, no fee is required.

**PRO HAC VICE fees:** Although the fee to file a Pro Hac Vice Motion in the U. S. District Court for the Western District of Tennessee is now \$100.00, the fee in the Bankruptcy Court will remain at \$10.00 until further notice.

**APPEAL RELATED FEES:**

To file an appeal or cross appeal from a judgment, order or decree = **Total: \$298.00**  
**(\$5.00 pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 1930; \$293.00 pursuant to Misc. Item (14))**

Upon notice from the court of appeals that a direct appeal or direct cross appeal from the bankruptcy court has been authorized, an **additional** fee of **\$207.00** must be collected.

**Please Note:** If a trustee or debtor in possession is the Appellant, Misc. Item (14) should only be payable only from the estate and to the extent there is any estate realized.
