Requires the email be sent to the appropriate email address, either:

- delk\_orders@ch13gws.com

the order be attached in:

• PDF format

the subject line of the email to include:

- the judges name
- the case number
- the related document number

## THE NEW PROCEDURE:

Requires the email be sent to:

• orders@ch13gws.com

the order be attached in:

• PDF format with <u>a filename less than 60 characters that does not include symbols or</u> <u>punctuation</u> (underlines or periods (\_\_\_\_\_) are acceptable)

the subject line of the email to include:

• **only** the case number

After emailing the order to us, <u>you will receive a automated reply message indicating either that</u> <u>your order is being processed or that an error occurred that requires your attention.</u>
